Teaching & Learning

The M.Ed. with a concentration in **Teaching & Learning** features relevant courses for today's classroom teacher. The program provides opportunities for continuing professional development for the experienced classroom teacher in the areas of curriculum, instruction and leadership. Classes are offered in traditional and online formats, with several courses offering a blended technology structure.

Instructional Leadership

The concentration in **Instructional Leadership** is a licensure curriculum to prepare school principals and curriculum supervisors. This degree provides opportunity for students to develop their knowledge and skills toward becoming leaders in schools and school districts. Applicants must have completed a minimum of three years of teaching prior to starting this degree program. Students completing the Instructional Leadership track must successfully pass the state licensure exam to obtain both the M.Ed. degree and state licensure.
