THE SERVICES OF UNION STATION. Union Station, a centralized service center, is located outside the Penick Administrative Center. Team members of Union Station are ready to assist you in a variety of areas including admissions, academic records, financial aid and student accounts.

Services related to finances include check cashing, check on the status of or make payment toward your student account, change meal plans, obtain refund requests & tuition waiver forms, pick up workshop and student payroll checks, purchase postage stamps, turn in financial aid forms, and sign for loans and financial aid awards. You may also deposit money to or check on the balance of your Dawg Tag account.

Services related to academic records include drop/add of classes, registration for classes during open registration periods, check on open/closed status of classes, request verification of enrollment, request a transcript, receive information on credit hours earned and transferred, and file a change of name or address.

Pick up information for a friend interested in attending Union University from Union Station.

The easy thing to remember: Ask Union Station first!

FINALIZATION OF PROPOSED SCHEDULES AND FUTURE PUBLICATIONS. Schedules for Winter & Spring 2003 will be available in final form before the Priority Registration, which is scheduled to begin November 4. Schedules for Summer 2003 will be published prior to Spring 2003. No proposed form of the Summer Schedule will be published prior to that publication.

Fall 2003 and proposed schedules for 2004 will be published approximately two weeks before Priority Registration for Summer and Fall 2003 opens in April 2003.

APPLICATION FOR GRADUATION. Students who plan to complete graduation requirements during spring semester or summer term must file an Application for Graduation in the Academic Center during the fall semester. A graduation meeting will be scheduled during late September or early October to fill out the Application.

Students who plan to complete requirements during fall semester or winter term must file an Application for Graduation during the spring semester. A meeting will be scheduled during late February or early March to fill out the Application.

Juniors and Seniors will be notified of the meeting by campus mail. See also "Degree Audit" below.

DEGREE AUDIT. Students should schedule a Degree Audit with the Assistant Registrar or Director of Teacher Education during their junior year and update with a 2nd appointment during their senior year. A Degree Audit is a review of the student's credits based on degree, major, minor and catalogue year. Applicants for graduation anticipating completion spring or summer must schedule an audit by the previous Dec. 1; applicants for fall semester or winter must, by the previous May 1, or they may be notified their Application for Graduation has been cancelled.

ACADEMIC POLICIES REGARDING REGISTRATION

Minimum and Maximum Credit Hour Loads. To be classified as a full-time student during a Fall or Spring Semester, a student must carry a credit hour load of 12 or more hours; for full-time status in Winter Term or each of the Summer Terms a student must carry a minimum of 3 hours. Audited courses do not apply toward minimum full-time status. Full-time status can be important in terms of the awarding of Financial Aid and deferring previous student loans and in matters of insurance coverage.

The maximum hours recommended for any student is 18 for a Fall or Spring Semester, 9 for accelerated 8-week sessions and 7 for any of the three 4-hour terms. However, a highly motivated student with a 3.0 GPA may petition the Registrar with the consent of the faculty advisor for permission to enroll for more than the suggested maximum.

Concurrent Enrollment. Concurrent enrollment with another college or university always must be approved in advance in writing by the Registrar.

Types of Enrollment: Audit vs. Credit. Students will be allowed to audit courses for personal enrichment on a space available basis. Audited courses do not apply toward graduation nor toward full-time status. Enrollment is considered to be for credit unless specified by the student as enrollment for audit; audit should be noted on the registration or add form and verbally communicated at the time of registration and must occur during the published registration period for the course.

A student auditing a course may process drop/add forms to earn credit in the course no later than the "Last Day to Add a Class" for the semester/term. A student enrolled in a course for credit may change to audit in accordance with the period allowed to drop a class. The "Last Day to Add a Class" and the "Last to Drop a Class" are noted in the academic calendar for the appropriate semester/term.

Types of Enrollment: Course Repeat. A student may repeat a course previously attempted at Union University to improve the grade in the course and his/her cumulative GPA. Notation of the repeat should be indicated on the registration or add form. If omitted at registration, the repeat coding may be added by notification to Union Station or the Academic Center.

The most recent grade earned in the course is the grade calculated in the cumulative GPA and in consideration for graduation.

Change of Classes/Drop & Add. After completing registration, a student desiring to make a schedule change, course or meeting time, or change enrollment type, credit or audit, will:

1. Obtain proper forms from Union Station
2. Secure the approving signature of his/her faculty advisor. The student must also sign the forms.
3. Present the forms to Union Station for the schedule change within the allotted time frame; refer to the appropriate calendar for "Last Day to Add a Class" and "Last Day to Drop a Class."

A change fee of \$10 will be charged for schedule changes after the start of classes.

Cross-Campus Agreement. Union, Lambuth and Freed-Hardeman Universities have developed a cross-registration agreement to allow students pursuing an undergraduate degree at one university to enroll in a course at any of the three. Union students must obtain permission from their faculty advisor and the Registrar. Additional information is available in the Academic Center.

Permission to Enroll in a Closed Class. The instructor of a course may allow admittance to his class after closing with his signature providing there is seating available and it is amenable to classroom instruction. The instructor is not required to fill a room to its seating capacity; however, the instructor may not sign in beyond seating capacity.

WINTER TERM CONTINGENCY PLAN
