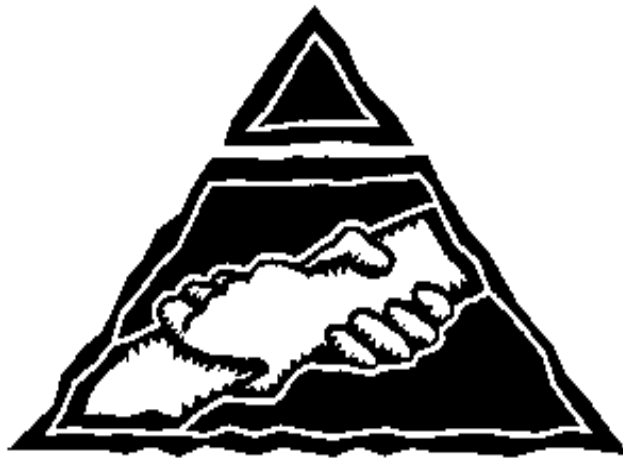

- ◆ Being held accountable by the Campus Ministries staff.
- ◆ Being personally and intentionally involved with each member (of the same gender) in your group.
- ◆ A weekly meeting with your LIFE Group in the Fall of 2008.
- ◆ Contacting your group (encourage/call/fellowship) throughout the semester.
- ◆ Being willing not to date within your LIFE Group during the Fall semester.
- ◆ Writing a covenant with other leaders that detail your calling as a LIFE Group Leader.

- ◆ LIFE Group Leader Orientation, **August 18-20, 2008** and New Student Orientation (Focus), August 21-24, 2008.
