Register Early

Since class sizes are limited and many fill quickly, we encourage you to register by Aug. 4 for the fall semester. In order to register, please send in the \$10 registration fee PLUS the cost of materials. Registering before classes are scheduled to begin also ensures that we will have your child's materials available at the first class.

Payments and Refunds

Kindermusik® is a very affordable way to enrich your young child's life. It only costs approximately \$10 a week (not including materials) for your child to be involved. Please do not let finances keep you from this wonderful program. Payment plan options are available. Tuition refunds may be requested due to an unexpected family move. In situations which would necessitate withdrawal from the class, such as serious illness or family emergencies, et., a credit voucher for a future session of *Kindermusik* classes may be given. We regret that refunds cannot be offered for family materials.

Making the Most of *Kindermusik*® Classes

The most important thing you can do for your child is to be an active but patient role model. Your child may not follow the teacher at first, but they will follow you. In fact, it often takes several classes for many children to begin to feel comfortable in the class. Don't be discouraged – what's most important is what the children do musically at home. The understanding and consistency of the parent or caregiver both in class and at home are key to the process of musical learning and growth being facilitated. We love for parents to socialize and fellowship before or after class, but not during class time, please. When you are an active, focused, enthusiastic participant in the class activities, your child will model your actions and focus more fully too.

You and your child will enormously benefit from the *Kindermusik*® experience, especially if you make active use of your *At Home Materials*. Frequent reinforcement at home makes all the difference in a children's comfort and participation in the classroom.
