*F*rom private lessons to large ensembles, the Department of Music at Union University has musical experiences available to all enrolled students, regardless of musical background or declared major. Students just beginning to explore music will add to their collegiate experience through active participation in the arts, finding teachers capable, insightful, and patient. At the same time, those arriving at Union University with substantial background and training will discover new levels of musicianship and increased skill and understanding through exposure to demanding literature, exemplary instruction, high expectations, and memorable performances. In all cases, students should simply register for the appropriate course and join the Department of Music as we **EXALT** and **INSPIRE**.

CHOIRS

**Choral Union (MUS 108)** is open to all university students and does not require an audition. Rehearsing two days each week, the ensemble performs two concerts each fall and one in the spring, singing music from a wide array of genre and periods.



**University Singers (MUS 191)** is an auditioned, mixed choir that tours annually each spring and internationally every third year. Singers rehearses four times weekly and gives at least three performances each semester. Literature is selected from every time period and style, ranging from a cappella pieces to multi-movement works accompanied by orchestra.

**Proclamation** serves as the public relations ensemble for the Department of Music and Union University. Consisting of 18 auditioned voices, membership of Proclamation is chosen from University Singers and is accompanied by an annual scholarship. This ensemble performs frequently throughout each semester in a wide variety of venues, singing for local congregations as well as national and international dignitaries.

## BANDS



Students with instrumental experience are encouraged to register for **Symphonic Band (MUS 135)**. This ensemble is open to all university students and rehearses three times weekly. The Symphonic band performs once each term, presenting a variety of compositions and transcriptions. Scholarships are available to members of Symphonic Band through audition.

The **Jazz Band** of Union University (MUS 100) performs one concert each term to a packed house of adoring fans. Focusing on literature from big band to contemporary jazz expressions, this non-auditioned ensemble practices one evening each week.

Ringling 5 octaves of English bells, the Union University **Handbell Choir (MUS 165)** offers a unique opportunity to students of all backgrounds and experiences.
