2006-07 Student Film Festival Rules & Description

This is the fourth annual Union Student Film Festival. We've had some great entries in the past and we're looking forward to more this year.

This festival exists to provide a public venue for the screening of student films. Its purpose is to encourage young filmmakers at Union and give them a platform to showcase their talents.

The Rules

The rules are pretty simple.

1. You must have been a full-time Union student when you completed the film.
2. The entry must have been completed between **November 2005 and March 2007** (we moved the festival to the spring this year).
3. The film cannot exceed 30 minutes.
4. The film's content should meet university standards. The Festival Director reserves the right to exclude submitted films that are not appropriate for the festival.
5. The film can appear on the Festival DVD if the filmmaker grants us permission and the filmmaker holds the appropriate copyrights.

Festival Description & Timeline

- **March 15, 2007** - Films are due by 4:30pm. Films should be submitted on DVD and/or MiniDV with the submission form to Cam Tracy – PAC, F-74. We prefer that the film be on MiniDV, so that we will have the highest quality media to work from when putting together the Festival DVD.
- **March 19, 2007** - The films will be reviewed and filmmakers will be notified of its acceptance.
- **March 19 – 25, 2007** - The films will be judged in Technical and Acting categories. Additional Trivial categories will be determined based upon the films submitted.
- **March 26, 2007** – Screening & Directors' Talk, W.D. Powell Theater, 6pm – each director's film will be shown and there will be a brief Q&A time with the filmmakers.
- **March 27, 2007** – Screening & Awards, W.D. Powell Theater, 6pm – each film will be shown again and around 8:30pm we will present the Festival Awards. Grand prizes will be given for the **Best Long Form Film** (10 minutes or more), **Best Short Form Film** (less than 10 minutes) and **Students' Choice** (voted on during Directors' Talk). Additional awards will be given in specific categories for Technical achievement and Acting achievement. Trivial Awards are given for memorable moments from the films.
