Section 3: Qualifications and Guidelines

1. The student must be a member of a Southern Baptist Church.
2. The student must be enrolled in a Tennessee Baptist college or university.
3. The student must have experienced a call by God to a full-time Christian ministry.
 - He/She will have shared their call through a public surrender in a worship service at the church of which he/she is a member.
 - The student will indicate the specific area of ministry to which he/she has been called. This may require a semester or even a year of counsel with the pastor, family, and much prayer in order for the student to define a specific area of ministry.
4. The student is **required** to attend the CCMS orientation meeting and at least three CCMS sponsored events each semester. The student is expected to set goals in the areas of personal spiritual growth, ministry skill development, and local church involvement that he/she will actively pursue. These goals are to be documented and submitted to the Office of Church Relations. Failure to attend these meetings or submit the required documents may result in the loss of all or a portion of the CCM Scholarship.
5. The student must maintain a **2.0 grade point average** in order to continue receiving the CCM Scholarship.
6. The student may receive the CCM Scholarship for eight semesters. Special permission from the Director of Church Relations is required for an additional semester.
7. A CCMS student involved in a behavioral infraction resulting in disciplinary probation will forfeit the CCM Scholarship during the period of probation.
