



ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Please submit to the Office of Student Financial Planning

Qualified students to Union University's engineering program are eligible to receive a \$8,000 annual scholarship. Engineering scholars may also receive Union Non-Merit Based Awards. Please contact a representative from Student Financial Planning or Undergraduate Admissions for further information. This scholarship applies only to Fall and Spring terms.

Requirements

- Any student, new or returning, majoring in engineering may receive an engineering scholarship.
- Freshman students should have taken and passed High School Calculus or equivalent series of mathematics as determined by the department of Engineering to be successful in Calculus I at Union.
- Freshman and Transfer students, as well as currently enrolled Union University students, must be reviewed and approved by engineering department in order to declare a major in engineering and to receive an engineering scholarship.

Renewal

- Students must maintain 2.5 cumulative GPA and be making adequate progress toward completion of the degree.
- New freshman students may receive the scholarship for a maximum of five consecutive years (10 semesters).
- New transfer students (and currently enrolled Union students) will receive assistance based upon projected number of semesters required to complete the engineering degree at the time of initial transfer to Union.
- Students who receive engineering scholarships and then change majors will forfeit their engineering scholarships, but may apply for other institutional financial aid.
