ADMISSION CRITERIA

Advanced Standing: Students with a BSW degree from a regionally accredited college or university:

• 3.00 overall GPA or higher

Regular Standing: Students with a bachelor's degree in another discipline from a regionally accredited college or university:

• 2.65 overall GPA or higher

Applicants are not required to take the GRE

THE MSW PROGRAM OFFERS

- Options with classes held only one evening a week.
- One to three year degree tracks are available
- Curriculum includes rigorous coursework and relevant clinical practice at local agencies
- MSW degree requires a total of 60 hours of credit, or 33 hours for Advanced Standing
- The Master of Social Work program at Union University is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education
