## 2005 Entry Form and Rules

**Deadline for Entry: Wednesday, October 19**

### Entry Criteria

- The entry must be submitted by a student of Union University.
- The entry may not have been screened at a previous Union University Student Film Festival.
- The film's content is the responsibility of the filmmaker and he or she should be prepared to defend it in discussion if necessary.
- The festival directors reserve the right to accept or reject any entry at their discretion.
- A festival DVD will be sold at the awards show. Accepted entries containing copyrighted material (music, images, film clips, etc.) will not appear on the festival DVD, but may still be shown at the festival. Copyright free material may also be added to the Union Video Project.

### Submission Formats

- Entries must be submitted prior to the entry deadline on DVD or mini-DV.
- All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form, signed and dated with all information printed or typed clearly and completely.
- A separate entry form must accompany each entry.
- Do not submit works in progress or rough cuts.
- Entries should be submitted to Cam Tracy (F-74 in the PAC).

### Screening Format

- All films will be shown from a DVD.
- By submitting your film, you are agreeing to allow it to be placed on a film festival DVD which will be distributed to festival judges and film directors.
- Following the screening for audience voting, you will be expected to appear for a brief discussion of your film – Nov. 1 in the theatre.

### Festival Dates

- *Screening: Tuesday, Nov. 1, 7:00 PM in W.D. Powell Theatre* – All accepted films will be shown and the directors should be prepared to engage in a brief discussion about their films. Students will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite film which will win the student's choice award.
- *Second Screening and Awards: Thursday, Nov. 3, 6 PM in Harvey Hall* – All accepted films will be screened a second time. At 9 PM, the awards ceremony will begin – red carpet at 8:45 PM.

### Competition and Awards

- Films will be accepted for competition in two categories: long form (over 10 minutes) and short form (under 10 minutes).
- There will be two grand prize jury awards (one for long form and one for short form).
- There will be one student's choice award which all films are eligible for.
- There will be 15 additional awards which all films are eligible for (acting awards, technical awards, and trivial awards).
