Any undergraduate major is acceptable; however, biology and chemistry majors will be the best prepared.

While evidence of clinical experience is not required for admission, it is highly recommended because such experience is believed to be an accurate indicator of an individual's desire and commitment to engage in health care service. In the opinion of the program faculty, past medical experience also provides a framework for students to build upon and can facilitate the expansion of their fund of medical knowledge.

AVERAGE GPA OF LAST ENTERING CLASS

While no information about last class is available, the lowest acceptable GPA of applicants is 3.25.

AVERAGE SCORE OF ENTRANCE EXAM OF LAST ENTERING CLASS

Graduate Record Exam (GRE) is required and a combined verbal/quantitative minimum score of 800 is required.

Additional Note: applicants must submit three letters of recommendations (one from a physician or physician assistant; one from a college professor; and one from an employer.)
