- ◆ Union University School of Nursing application with application fee
- ◆ Official transcripts from all undergraduate and graduate coursework
- ◆ Last 60 hours GPA minimum 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for graduate coursework
- ◆ Completed Bachelor of Science degree, preferably in nursing, from an accredited program
- ◆ Completed Master's degree in Nursing from an accredited program. Degrees other than MSN may be considered but may require additional coursework prior to enrollment
- ◆ Current unencumbered RN and APN licensure (if applicable) in state of residence
- ◆ Eligible for licensure as RN and/or APN in Tennessee
- ◆ Current National Certification for NP or Nurse Anesthesia track
- ◆ If not a US Citizen, applicants must complete the International Student application, TOEFL, and have international transcripts evaluated through World Education Services
- ◆ Three letters of professional/academic reference specifying the applicant's capabilities for doctoral study (one letter of reference must be from current supervisor)
- ◆ Statement of past clinical and/or work experiences, scholarly activities and community service that supports one's future goals in obtaining a practice doctorate
- ◆ GRE and GMAT not required
