




First-Destination Survey: May 2016 Graduating Undergraduates




Of the 217 undergraduate students who responded or for whom we received information via phone, email, or written report (totaling a 73% survey rate of return) 91% of our graduates have either secured employment and/or are applying to/have been accepted into grad school. Considering the effects of the economic downturn and the adverse effects on college graduates nationwide, this placement rate is commendable and demonstrates a growth in comparison with the previous year indicating that placement for Union University remains competitive with, and, in many cases, is more positive than other higher education institution graduates throughout the nation.

Of the 25% of students going directly on to graduate school, 96% are going immediately, and 4% are going within one year. Of that 25%, the breakdown by area/discipline is as follows: Health & Human Sciences 6%, Social Work 6%, Business (Includes MBA and MAcc) 9%, Education 8%, Counseling 11%, Law 2%, Art/Science 8%, Physical Therapy 15%, Nursing 4%, Occupational Therapy 6%, Pharmacy 4%, Theology 11%, and Not Specified 11%.






Of the 171 undergraduate students who responded or for whom we received information via phone, email, or written report (totaling a 55% survey rate of return) 93% of our graduates have either secured employment and/or are applying to/have been accepted into grad school. Considering the effects of the economic downturn and the adverse effects on college graduates nationwide, this placement rate is commendable and demonstrates a growth in comparison with the previous year indicating that placement for Union University remains competitive with, and, in many cases, is more positive than other higher education institution graduates throughout the nation.

Of the 43% of students going directly on to graduate school, 68% are going immediately, and 32% are going within one year. Students indicating an intent to go to graduate school within the next 5 years totaled approximately 41% of all students interested in graduate school and 29% of all student respondents. Of that 43%, the breakdown by area/discipline is as follows: Health & Human Sciences 13%, Social Work 7%, Business (Includes MBA, MAcc, Economics and Sports Administration) 10%, Education 6%, Counseling 8%, Communication/Public Relations 3%, Art/Science 18%, Physician's Assistant 3%, Physical Therapy 4%, Nursing 4%, Occupational Therapy 3%, Pharmacy 4%, and Theology 11%.


