Important Tips for New Residential Students

| Before Move-In Day (Friday, August 21 st): | We encourage you to contact your future roommates prior to move-in day to coordinate who will bring certain large items to place in the living room and kitchen. (Microwave- for Heritage students only, TV, etc.) |
| How to get to campus: | For maps and directions to campus, please refer to the Undergraduate Admissions website at http://www.uu.edu/campusvisits/maps.cfm . |
| Where to go on Move-In Day: | When you arrive on campus, there will be students at each main entrance to direct you where to park. From there you will go to the Move-In Day Headquarters in the Fred Delay gymnasium to register for orientation, complete housing and health forms, and receive your apartment and bedroom keys. After completing the Move-In Day process at Headquarters, you will be ready to move in! |
| Important for completing your Emergency Information Card at Move-In Day Headquarters: | <u>Make sure you have your/your parents' HMO/medical insurance company name and policy number, medical conditions, medications, and your parents' cell phone numbers to write on the Emergency Card.</u> |
| If you were unable to attend the New Student Registration Day (Monday, June 15 th): | Make sure to bring current proof of car insurance and your driver's license to register your car in the Office of Safety and Security on Move-In Day. |
| When unpacking and decorating your room: | We ask that you only use small, size 4 nails to hang decorations, hooks, etc. on the wall. No screws, putty or tape should be used at any time. Also, as you unpack and discard boxes, please flatten cardboard boxes and stack them next to the dumpsters to be recycled. |

| Curfew for the first week of school: | Monday through Thursday nights of the first week of school, freshmen (only) are required to be in their apartments by 11pm. After this time, curfew will be 2am, which is curfew for all residential Union students. | Your assigned room: | <p>If you are assigned to a bedroom in The Quads, you must move into your assigned bedroom (A, B, C, or D). If you prefer to share a bathroom with a roommate that lives on the opposite side of the apartment, we encourage you to communicate with each roommate, and make a plan before the semester begins.</p> <p>Also please note that the shelves in the left bathroom of downstairs apartments in the Quads should be shared by all roommates; there are not shelves in the right bathroom because the water heater is in the right bathroom. If you have any questions concerning your housing assignment, please contact us at reslife@uu.edu.</p> |
| Important to consider: | Union University's property insurance <u>will not</u> cover students' personal property. Union strongly recommends that students obtain Renter's Insurance. Students can also check their parents' Homeowner's Insurance as it sometimes covers students' property while at college. |
