Basic Charges for Rising Senior Program

Students participating in the Summer Rising Senior Program will be charged \$125 per credit hour. Students are allowed to enroll in a maximum of seven credit hours per four week term. The maximum tuition cost is \$875 per term. Room and board costs, lab fees, and dorm fees will apply at the regular rate to students living on campus.
