GEORGE DAVID CLARK

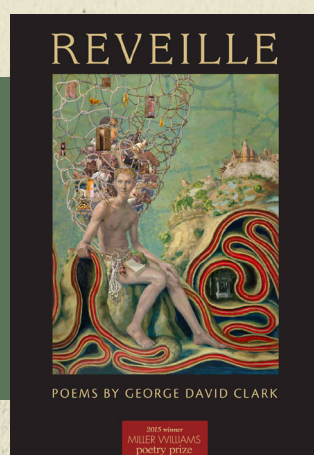

The author of *Reveille* (winner of the Miller Williams Poetry Prize from the University of Arkansas Press), Dr. Clark's recent poems can be found or are forthcoming in *AGNI*, *Alaska Quarterly Review*, *The Believer*, *Blackbird*, *Cincinnati Review*, *Yale Review*, and elsewhere.

After earning his bachelor's degree in English from Union University, an MFA from the University of Virginia, and a PhD from Texas Tech University, Dr. Clark held the Olive B. O'Connor Fellowship in Poetry at Colgate University and, later, the Lilly Postdoctoral Fellowship at Valparaiso University. He has received additional honors from *Southern Poetry Review* (the Guy Owen Prize), *Narrative Magazine* (the 30 Below Prize), and the Sewanee Writers' Conference (a Walter E. Dakin fellowship), among others. The current editor-in-chief of *32 Poems*, he teaches creative writing and literature as an assistant professor at Washington & Jefferson College.
