

## THE MASTER CLASS PROGRAM

is a monthly learning opportunity that addresses a specific arena of practice. Participants will receive 1.5 CEUs for each session they attend as well as 3.0 CEUs in Ethics for the November workshop.

A certificate will be offered for each month's learning opportunity and a Master Class Completion Certificate will be awarded to each person who completes the entire series.

The Master Class Series will include continuing education offerings in clinical settings, faith and social work practice, and community development. The 2020 topic is the Trauma Informed Care.



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The class will meet on the second Friday of each month. The workshops will begin at 8:30 and concluded at 10:00, with the exception of the November ethics workshop that will be from 8:30-11:30.

Each month the class will cover a different aspect of trauma and response to trauma. The classes will be taught by faculty of the Union University School of Social Work and community members with expertise in specific practice areas.
