CONNECT CAMP WILL FOCUS ON

- Foundational competencies in beginning algebra such as combining terms, simplifying expressions, and solving and graphing equations
- Quantitative and abstract reasoning through the use of words, symbols, tables, and graphs

WHO SHOULD ATTEND THE CAMP?

- Students entering the 9th grade in the fall who want to enter high school prepared to succeed in Algebra I.

Dr. Hail believes that students learn best when they can form connections between mathematical concepts and skills, representations of mathematical ideas, and real-world applications. He encourages students to explore building these connections and enjoy using their math skills outside the classroom.
