

# **Graduate International Application Form**

(to be submitted with application)

Thank you for considering Union University for your education. We are pleased you are applying and look forward to helping you during the application process. Please feel free to contact the International Student Program if you have any questions as you complete the International Student Application and supply the required documents.

Please note, this form is to be completed in addition to the application for admission to your specific program of interest. This international application should be attached to the program-specific application furnished by the academic program you are applying for. It is your responsibility to be aware of the additional admission requirements of your program, such as test scores or departmental interviews, and to contact the program's admissions office for further information.

### **International Applicants**

This form is to be completed by the students meeting the criteria listed below, if you are:

- Currently in your home country and intend on obtaining an F-1 student visa and I-20 to study in the USA.
- Currently in the U.S.A on an F-1 visa who will be notifying your current DSO to transfer your SEVIS record to Union University and you intend on obtaining an I-20 from Union University to study.

  You must complete the same process to obtain an I-20, and include the necessary documents. However, you and your current International Student Adviser/DSO must also complete the "Transfer-In Form" available at www.uu.edu/international.
- Currently in the U.S.A on a non-immigrant visa other than F-1, who will be *changing* your status to an F-1 visa and obtaining an I-20 with the sole intention of studying in the United States.
- Currently in the U.S.A on a non-immigrant visa other than F-1 (such as an H-1B), and plan on attending Union University while continuing in current visa status. You are not changing your visa status.

You must provide supporting documents of your current visa status in the United States. Complete page 1 of the International Application form, numbers #1-13.

- Currently in the U.S.A as a permanent resident and wish to attend Union University.

You must provide proof of permanent residency, English proficiency, and official transcripts. Complete page 1 of the International Application Form, numbers #1-13.

## **Official Transcripts**

International transcripts must be evaluated using a NACES approved transcript evaluation service that indicates the degree completed as it equates to U.S. degrees. All evaluations must be sent to the university registrar directly. Please note, you must provide an official (sealed) transcript and evaluation that meets the requirements of your specific program for which you are applying. All undergraduate programs require a course-by-course evaluation; many of the graduate programs only require an evaluation of your degree. If you have classes from another institution that you wish to transfer to Union for the degree you are pursuing, you will need a course-by-course evaluation. If you only need to verify an existing degree and plan to take all courses at Union, then you will only need an evaluation of your degree. Please verify with your program coordinator regarding the specific transcript requirement needed. Union University only accepts transcript evaluations from an approved NACES member. ### **Documentation of English Proficiency**

If English is not your native language, you are required to display English Proficiency by submitting official scores from one of the following:

- 1. Test of English in a Foreign Language (TOEFL),
- 2. 2. IELTS, or
- 3. 3. iTEP

Applicants who do not meet minimum English proficiency will not be admitted. An **exemption** of proof of English proficiency requirement may be granted only when the applicant has received or is pursuing an acceptable degree from an accredited English-speaking college or university.

#### **Declaration of Finances**

If you are applying with the intention of an obtaining an F-1 visa, please request and complete the Declaration of Finances form to show proof of finances which will support you during your studies at Union University. Submit the form and supporting documents along with this application to the International Student Advisor at pwhitnell@uu.edu.
