Initiative Goals and Student Learning Outcomes

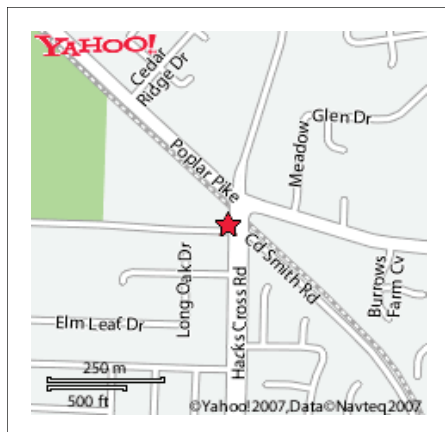
