- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Two positive reference forms
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Three dispositional evaluations (2 completed by professors of first two classes and one self-evaluation)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Successful completion of first portfolio submission in EDU 535.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Complete background check and fingerprinting as required by state law if not currently teaching full time
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Approval by the School of Education Faculty
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. Approval by the Teacher Education Committee

**In order to remain in the Educator Preparation Program, all the following requirements must be met.**
