In response, the Draces introduced Hope for the Home, a conference which takes families through a weekend series of messages to strengthen marriages, communications and parenting.


The Draces are encouraged by the positive response to Hope for the Home. They continually hear from families who have committed to reading the Bible together and the difference it is making in their lives.


